

What Guidance Does LBUSD Use for Health and Safety Measures?

The City of Long Beach and its health department (Long Beach Health and Human Services) have issued health orders as a means of controlling the spread of COVID-19.

The City's health orders align with other public health agencies in the region, including Los Angeles County Public Health and the City of Los Angeles, as well as the State of California. These health orders guide decisions on measures including but not limited to:

- Required wearing of face masks in indoor settings
- Reporting of COVID-19 cases
- Contact tracing and home quarantine of close contacts
- Vaccine verification and diagnostic testing
